### **ASPIRE Hours at Butler Tech's LeSourdsville Campus**

Orientation to start paperwork and pretesting is every Monday with daytime hours of 9am-12pm and evening hours 5:30-8:30pm.

Class times are Monday-Thursday 9am-12pm.

Once you're prepared to take the test, go on the GED website <https://ged.com/> to register and choose our LeSourdsville campus as the testing site. If you're already 18, there is an opportunity for an \$80 voucher for first-time GED test takers. The cost of GED in Ohio is \$120 (\$30 for each of the four subject tests), so with the voucher you would only pay \$40. You will just need to meet with our Financial Aid Coordinator Denny Ewen to see if you qualify and to get the voucher code. His email is
