

Daily Home Screening for Students and Staff

Please complete this self-evaluation each morning before leaving to come to Butler Tech:

SECTION 1

Symptoms

If you have any of the following symptoms, that indicates a possible illness and/or puts you at risk for spreading illness to others, do NOT attend school.

- Temperature 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher when taken by mouth
- Sore throat
- New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing (for students with chronic allergic/asthmatic cough, a change in their cough from baseline)
- Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain
- New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever
- Sudden loss of taste or smell

SECTION 2

Close Contact and/or Potential Exposure

If you have had any of the following that could put you or others at risk, do NOT attend school.

- Had close contact (within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes) with a person with confirmed COVID
- Have been tested for COVID and are currently awaiting results – even if asymptomatic
- Have received a positive COVID test result
- Have received official word from Butler Tech and/or the Butler County Health Department that you are to quarantine for a specified amount of time

Butler Tech is making decisions based on science and data provided by the Center for Disease Control, guidelines from the Ohio Department of Health, the Butler County Health Department and mandates initiated by Governor DeWine. This is a fluid situation and we are continually monitoring and adjusting our plans to meet current health and safety recommendations and to ensure the wellbeing of our students and staff.
