GENERAL DESCRIPTION	RISE Up is a training and credentialing program that provides foundational employability skills to help people both land a job and get promoted in retail and beyond. Based out of the Fairfield Township Campus, this Instructor will travel daily across various Butler Tech campuses and associate schools to deliver curriculum to 9 th – 12 th grade students so that they may earn 12-points of industry credentials that meet graduation requirements.

Credential preparation will occur within a condensed College and Career Readiness course delivered in both in-person and virtual formats. The Instructor will facilitate modules, monitor student progress and readiness, and deliver assessments in retail industry fundamentals and customer service areas to students on a rotating basis in addition to teaching leadership, team building, communication, and career exploration skills.

Additional opportunities to support student credential and/or graduation options may also be explored as part of this position.

| QUALIFICATIONS

- Appropriate licensure/certification through the Ohio Department of Education (ODE) or ability to obtain proper licensure. Applicants must meet **ONE OF THE FOLLOWING** requirements to be considered for this position:
 - Current ODE licensure in CT Family and Consumer Science Education (090120) **OR**
 - Meets all four criteria below: **OR**
 - Holds a bachelor's degree; **AND**
 - Holds a valid Ohio Resident Educator, Professional, Permanent or Five-Year Career-Technical teaching license in any field; **AND**
 - Passes (or has passed) the [OAE content-knowledge test for Family Consumer Science \(022\)](#); **AND**
 - Submits to a transcript review by Ohio Department of Education to ensure appropriate grade level pedagogy course has been completed;
- If credential not already held, must successfully complete Rise Up Proctor credentialing process prior to the start of the 2022 – 2023 school year;
- Background in the area of business or a related field;
- Willingness and ability to travel and operate/organize a schedule to meet student and district needs;
- Willingness and ability to work with students, teachers and administrators as a team member;

- Effective and demonstrated problem solving, critical thinking, analytical, oral and written communication, and organizational skills;
- Valid drivers' license; reliable transportation, and vehicle insurance;
- History of an effective work record, including good job attendance and performance;
- Documented evidence of acceptable criminal record/background check as required by Ohio law and Board Policy.
