Through a combination of in-class educational and on-site experiential learning opportunities, this instructor will maximize student success by preparing students for high school graduation, post-secondary education and training, and/or a meaningful career.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Applicants must meet **ONE OF THE FOLLOWING** requirements to be considered for this position. (shown in order of preference):
 - Ohio teacher licensure in Integrated Science Grades 7-12 AND Career Based Intervention (600100) endorsement; OR
 - Ohio teacher licensure in Integrated Science Grades 7-12 AND 2 years successful teaching experience under a standard teaching license AND 1 year full time work experience outside education AND willingness to enroll in Career Based Intervention coursework;
- Experience administering an experiential work-study program preferred;
- Willingness/ability to work with students, teachers and administrators as a team member;
- Effective and demonstrated problem solving, critical thinking, analytical, oral and written communication, and organizational skills;
- Valid driver license; reliable transportation, and vehicle insurance;
- History of strong work record, including good job attendance; and
- Documented evidence of acceptable criminal record as required by Ohio law and Board Policy.
