We are seeking a dynamic instructor to work with high school students in Grades 10-12 pursing a 3-year Teacher Pathway program that blends college-level academics with hands-on teaching experience, preparing students for success in higher education and the classroom.

Students will complete field placements in local schools, working alongside licensed teachers, and lead lessons on their own. Graduates of the program leave high school with valuable classroom experience, college credit, and guaranteed admission to Miami University's College of Education, Health, and Society.
